### FROM ITALIA RAFFRELE GUELI

### AMOR PATRIAE NOSTRA LEX


mor Patriae Nostra Lex, in Latin means: "the love of our country is our law". But who is a true patriot? I must sincerely concede that while us Americans are exaggeratedly, blatantly and lavishly patriots, many Italians, in my opinion, are not true patriots. Or if they are, they do not know the profound sense of patriotism that we feel. Every culture is unique. Our dictionary defines patriotism as: the feeling of love, pride, devotion and sense of attachment to a homeland.

In the USA most of us exhibit the stars and stripes all year round in front of our homes (I did it when I was living in Massachusetts) and the flag is displayed in all public buildings, banks, schools, post offices, sport arena and stadiums, etc. We have been taught in school that the flag must be respected, must never touch the ground and should not be trampled, soiled or used offensively as it When our narepresents our homeland. tional anthem is performed, it is customary to stand up, uncover our heads and bring our right hand over our heart. The military, and all members of the uniformed police forces, stand at attention and salute.

Here in Italy, the flag does not even get displayed on June 2nd, (Republic Day), but hangs from balconies only occasionally whenever the Italian national soccer team

plays in the World Cup. When the Italian national anthem is played, there are people who do not stand up and continue talking or using their smartphone as if respect for the national anthem is something trivial or insignificant. Members of the police force do not perform a military salute. It is reprehensible when not even journalists and sport commentators, as well as the staff of local television network, stand up. This is an irreverent lack of respect. Not to mention those who keep on screaming or making noise or beating the drums in the sport arena and stadiums. There is not even an Italian flag waving, and not just while the national anthem is performed, at which time it is customary to either sing (as I always do) or remain respectfully silent.

Here in Italy silence is not even observed when requested to make a moment of silence. Most Italians prefer to clap their hands. By all means, hands can be clapped before or after but never during that moment of recollection. I fail to understand which



part of the sentence is not clear. Unfortunately, incited by the mass, everyone starts to applaud, as if the majority would dictate law for all the sheep to copy. I can assure you by personal experience that Australians are highly patriotic, perhaps not as excessively as us, but much more than homeland Italians. Don't they proudly feel a strong sense of nationality? Don't they feel a fervent sentiment of devotion for their country? Of course, Italians do, yet sometimes they are ashamed to openly demonstrate these feelings. I know that I am a true Italian patriot, and above all, a true American patriot. God bless America.

However, that being said, I am happy to report that never before have I seen so many tricolored flags waiving from windows and balconies in these dire times as we fight our war against the Coronavirus pandemic. Homeland Italians are reluctant when it comes to expressing patriotic feelings in public, nevertheless they certainly do when the love for the country calls them to fight. **Viva L'Italia!**
